ITEM	Discussion	Follow up / Action
Crown Golf report	The issues related to weekend tee times have not been evident over the last few weeks mainly due to that fact that the weather has not been conducive for golf. Discussion on possible move to 5 days booking for non members has been looked at both locally and by CG in general and it is unlikely to change at present. The data for this will be gathered over the next few weeks in case there are questions at the AGM. The whole area of a member focussed club has been assessed and data shows that at Oak Park we are increasingly member oriented with roughly a 70/30 mix in favour of members.	
Craig's report	The golf course has held up well during the winter months and the heavy snow. The woodland was closed for 14/15 days because of the snow and is now open and the greens have been mowed and bunkers raked. There is work continuing on the turf lines on the 4 <sup>th</sup> which has been held up because of the weather. The mat on the 15 <sup>th</sup> will be removed and the path around that area will be looked at. New tee posts are now ready and will be in place for the Captain's drive in. The deep rough will be kept in order and cut before the start of the season to keep it manageable. The 5 <sup>th</sup> hole on the village will have the bunker redone.	
AOB	Concern over society booking on Bank Holiday Monday. RP admitted he had taken that booking and had asked them to change from Boxing day on the Saturday and forgot that the bank holiday was now the Monday. This will not happen again. Online booking error was explained and internal adjustments will now be in place to ensure that it doesn't reoccur. Honours boards will be put in ceiling soon and Fred Warren will contact RP to make sure that the alarms are moved.
